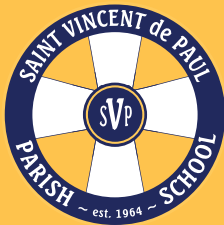

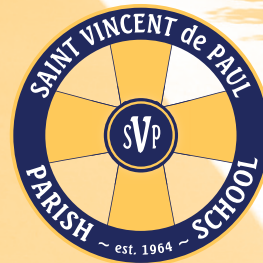

School Commission Chair's Letter

"Let's have this constant desire that the Kingdom of God may be extended... Let's keep this lamp lit always in our hearts."

Keeping the lamp lit. This has certainly been the cornerstone of St. Vincent de Paul School for over 50 years, and continues to describe our purpose well as we plan the years ahead. And it is with that purpose that the St. Vincent de Paul School Commission teamed with parents, staff and faculty to create this Five Year Plan—a plan based on the constant desire to move forward, to improve, and to better serve our students, our parish, and our community.

The process involved a thorough assessment of the ways our school excels, how it can improve, and how its activities can most effectively align with its mission, vision, and philosophy. This process led to the creation of a plan anchored in four main goal areas: (1) strengthening our Catholic identity, (2) maintaining excellent curricula, teachers, and leaders, (3) being an accessible and welcoming community, and (4) exercising wise stewardship of resources.

We will focus our efforts on these goals. Saint Vincent de Paul spoke of what he called "two beautiful virtues": perseverance to attain goals and constancy to overcome difficulties. Implementing this plan will indeed require both. But I am confident that together, as a community of parents, staff, and students, we will continue to move forward, keeping the lamp lit, in our hearts and in our school.

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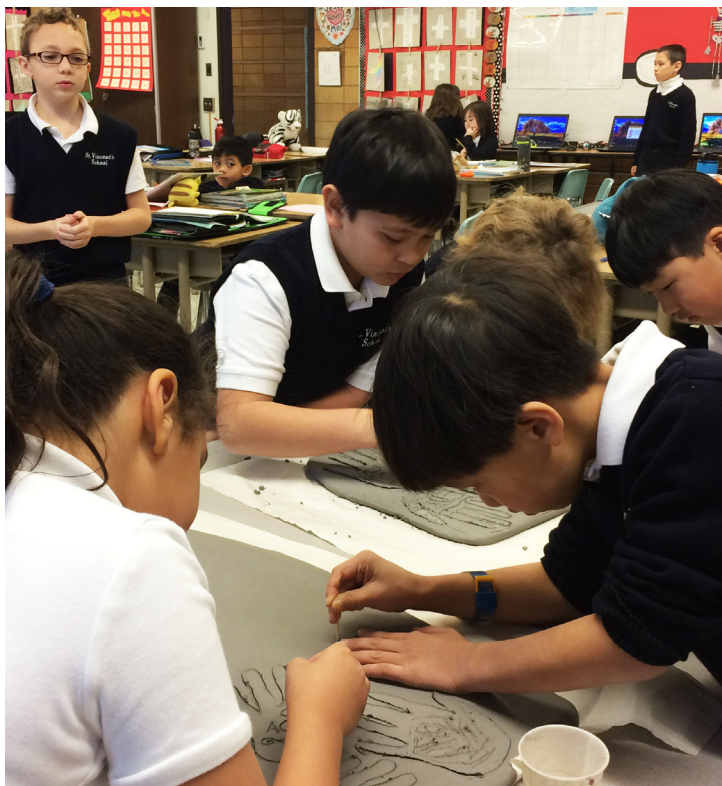
WISE STEWARDSHIP THROUGH PLANNING, GOVERNANCE, FUNDING, AND MARKETING
