DOMAIN 1: MISSION AND CATHOLIC IDENTITY

- The school will increase standards for teaching religion.
 - All teachers will meet Christ in the Classroom (CIC) requirements.
- The school will engage parents to support "Living the Gospel" with children.
 - Share with parents/guardians' religion curriculum.
 - Involve parents with service opportunities with their children at least once a year.
 - Invite and encourage school parents to participate in a parish-based adult faith formation.





DOMAIN 2: GOVERNANCE AND LEADERSHIP

- The school leadership team will direct the development and continuous improvement of curriculum and instruction and utilize school-wide data to plan for continued and sustained academic excellence and growth.
 - Hire a qualified vice principal to assist and support the principal with discipline, data analysis, instructional coaching, and progress monitoring.
- The school Commission will develop a formal instrument for self-evaluation.
 - Establish two to three goals annually.
 - Prepare formal procedures to evaluate progress of goals.

DOMAIN 3: ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE

- The school will meet the meet the students' learning and social emotional needs.
 - Continue to implement a universal Positive Behavior Intervention System (PBIS) program.
 - Consider hiring a school counselor part-time.
 - Consider implementing a Social Emotional Learning (SEL) curriculum.
- The school will maintain support of teacher salaries at 90% of the local district scale.





DOMAIN 4: OPERATIONAL VITALITY

- Establish an advancement management plan
 - Reinstate the Annual Fund.
 - Identify revenue resources, explore, and secure funding alternatives to meet schools' evolving needs.
 - · Collaborate with stakeholders.
- Create and implement facilities and technology management plan.
 - Create a plan for system maintenance, replacement cycles, and service renewals.
