This information is considered confidential under our agreement with KCLS as well as under the Family Education Rights and Privacy Act and KCLS will only use the information for the legitimate educational purpose of providing library access pursuant to our Agreement and will not re-disclose the information to any other party for any reason. We are excited about this opportunity. If you do not wish for your child to have a Student Account for the KCLS, please let me know in writing by January 31st.
