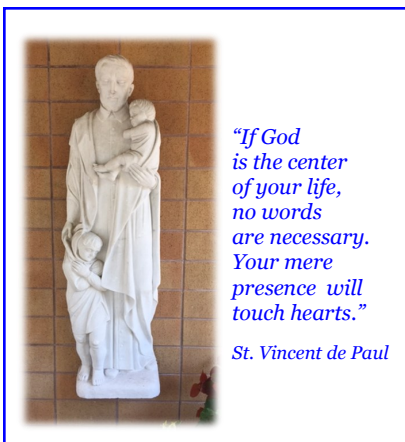
Carpool Arrival
