
Christmas Concert Information

Inclement Weather Reminders

If we have inclement weather, look for a school text message, and/or KING or KOMO TV websites for information for our school. I try to make the call for a late start or closure by 6am.

When we have a late start:

***School will begin at 10:30 that morning.

***There is no pre-k class that day.

***There is no am extended care.

***There is no am band.

Please drop off your child only if you see an adult outside waiting for children to arrive. Please allow plenty of space between the car in front of you as you come down 8th and in the driveway. This is for safety in case a car begins to slide. When we have snowy or icy roads, begin your drive to school only when you are comfortable driving given the road conditions. We do not count anyone tardy on an inclement day as safety is the first priority.
