CYO End-of-the-Year Banquet

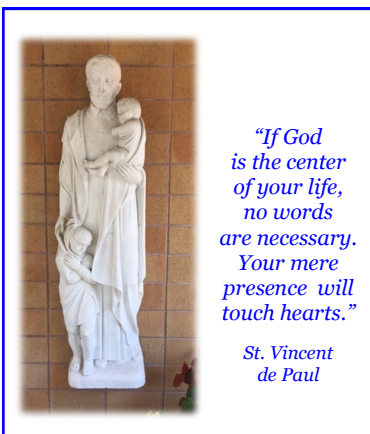
