- 1-2 volunteers to help during the reception following the Graduation Mass on June 8th at 7pm.

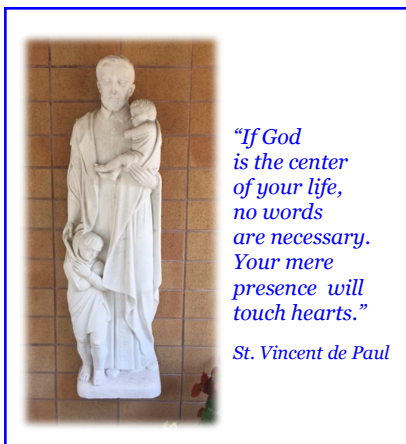
**Graduation Day Information, June 8**
