A Little Concern

I have been concerned about the number of tardies this year so we collected some data to think about. During the time from October 13th to November 7th, we had 314 tardies. This means that 314 students walked through the front door of the school after 8:30am. That is an average of 17 late students per day. This is something we need to work on. If every family came five minutes earlier each day, we could cut this number down to zero. Let's do it!
