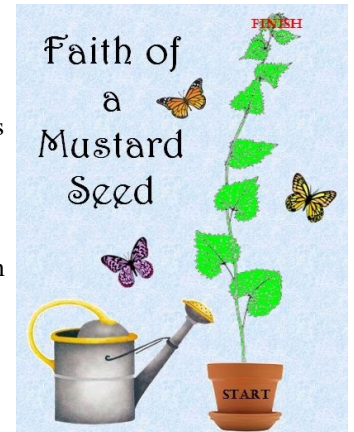

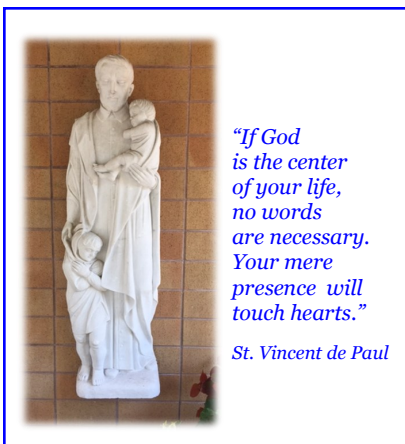
PowerSchool—We are working on parent IDs and passwords for our new PowerSchool and will send these out to you as soon as possible. Thank you for your patience.
