In order to provide the best possible atmosphere for our students, volunteer guidelines have been established. We ask all volunteers to read these and sign below.

- 1. Your commitment is valued. Please be on time.
- 2. If you are not able to meet your volunteer commitment, please make every effort to find another parent substitute. If you need help, please contact the school office.
- 3. Volunteers should sign in at the office when arriving at the school and sign out at the office before leaving. We ask that you wear a visitor's badge when you are at school. If you are volunteering for recess, please pick up a recess vest and wear it during recess.
- 4. Our students are happy to see parents and other helpers during the day. Your assistance and/or oversight should extend to all students identified by the teacher or principal, whether in the classroom, lunchroom, or on the playground.
- 5. Younger siblings should be left in the care of others while you are working in the classroom, office or on field trips. Younger siblings may be present during recess so long as you are able to direct your attention to the students having recess.
- 6. Cell phones are to be turned off while on school grounds or field trips.
- 7. Confidentiality regarding each student's learning and actions is expected. What happens in the classroom or among students is confidential and should not be discussed outside the school. If you have a concern, please see the teacher, playground supervisor, or principal.
- 8. As a volunteer, please know that you have the capacity to impact the success of many students. Your willingness to contribute is highly regarded by all.

The undersigned agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the parish and the Archdiocese of Seattle for any claim, liability, or expense arising from any contractual liability incurred or alleged to have been incurred by the undersigned. The undersigned further agrees that he/she is not entitled to any wages, reimbursements, or benefits from the volunteer work, including without limitation worker's compensation, unemployment benefits, medical and overtime. The undersigned agrees to make no claim for any injury, harm or consequential damages for work-related injury and releases the parish and the Archdiocese from all claims, demands, or causes of action arising there from.
